\*Our program is geared towards deep musical exploration. As such, we ask you to prepare and focus on <u>one short piece</u> or <u>one movement</u> of a larger work with your Artist(s) in Residence in guided rehearsals. Of course, please feel free to bring multiple solo works.

\*Upon acceptance to our program, a deposit of \$900 is required to reserve your place.

Participants who attend both sessions will receive a \$250 discount off the total cost of tuition.

## **Refund Policy:**

Due to the nature of the pandemic, we will be more flexible this year about refunding tuition. You will receive a full refund if you cancel two months before the start of the festival. You will receive a 50% refund if you cancel one month before the festival. If we must pivot to a virtual festival, we encourage you to attend the virtual festival, and the 2021 pianoSonoma at Your Doorstep tuition rates will apply.
